*There are increasingly frequent claims from workers and the public that many debilitating diseases are related to environmental and occupational exposures. Such claims often find their way into courts or the workers compensation system where objective evidence is needed in areas characterized by scientific uncertainty. This presentation will outline the fundamentals of an issue management approach for people concerned that their disease has been caused by chemical exposures. The approach begins with an understanding of the public's perception of risk, applies forensic occupational hygiene and toxicology, and requires painstaking attention to all forms of communication.*
